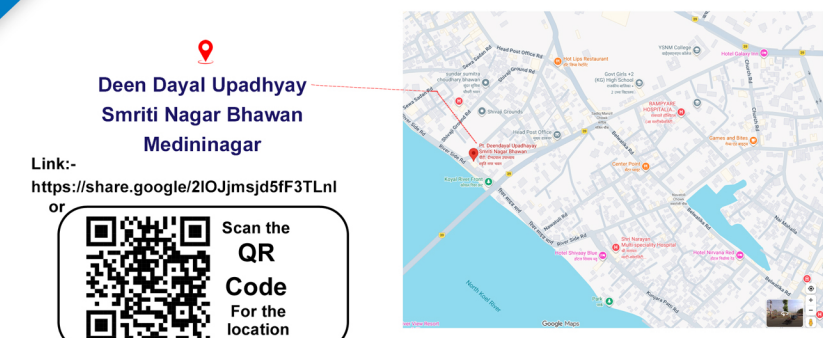

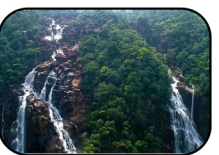


Visiting Sites



Netarhat
Netarhat is called the queen of hills. Apart from Kanyakumari, this is the only place where there is Sunrise and Sunset point. (117 Kms)

Lodh Falls
Lodh Fall is the highest fall of Jharkhand, whose height is 469 feet. (60 kms from Netarhat)



Betla National Park
It is a key part of the Palamu Tiger Reserve, which was one of the first 9 reserves in India, established under Project Tiger in 1974. (23 kms)

Kechki Sangam
North & South Koyal River (16 kms)



Palamu Fort
It is a national heritage site, built in the 17th century by Raja Pratap Rai and Medini Rai rulers of the Chero tribe, one of the 32 tribes of Jharkhand. He fought against the Mughals and the city of Medininagar is named after Raja Medini Rai (28 kms)

Shahpur Fort
Shahpur Fort is a state heritage, which is a part of Palamu Fort and was built by Raja Gopal Rai. (2 kms)



Malay Dam
A scenic, lesser-known picnic spot located in Satbarwa, Palamu district of Jharkhand. Built in the 1970s for irrigation, it features a large reservoir surrounded by seven hills, offering boating, natural beauty, and a serene escape often compared to a "mini-Kashmir" in winter. (33 kms)
