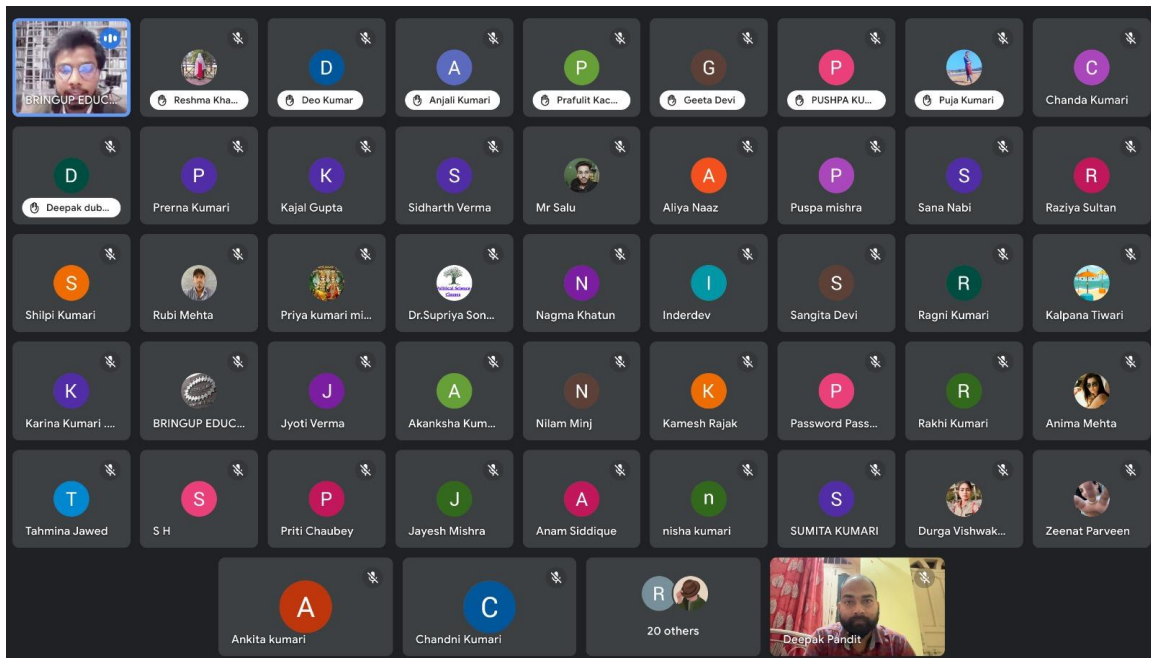

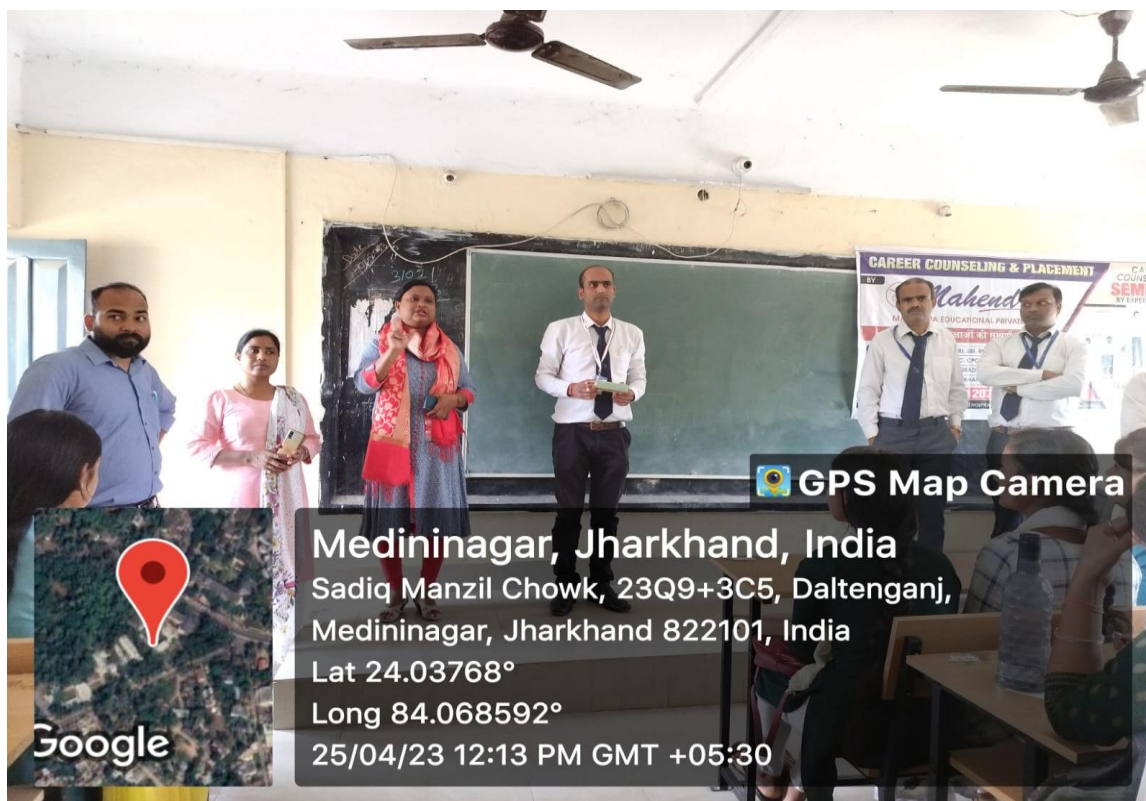

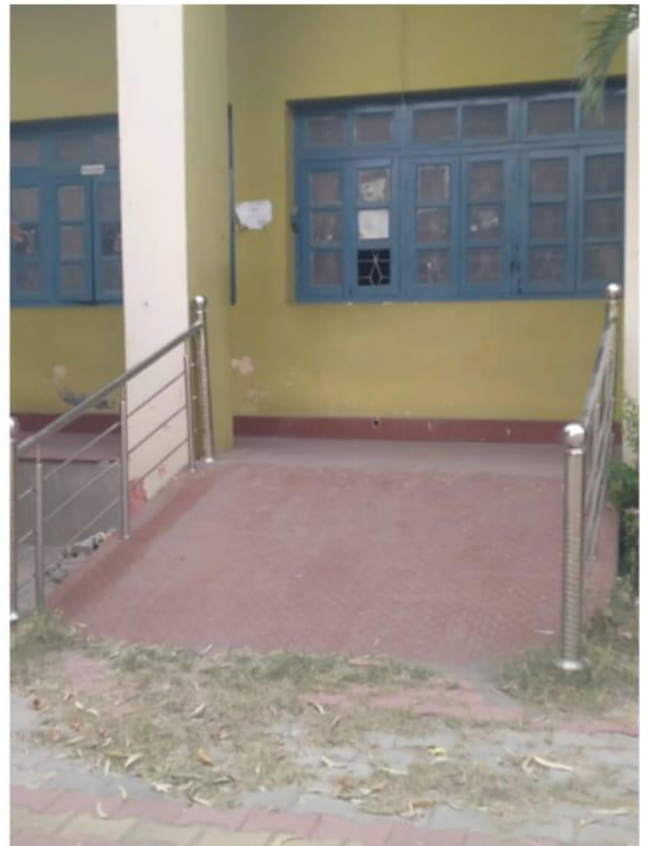
1. Girls Common room

Zero Tolerance

Zero Tolerance in Anti-Ragging" refers to a strict policy against ragging (hazing or bullying) in educational institutions, particularly in India. The goal is to prevent and prohibit any form of ragging, ensuring a safe and supportive environment for all students.

Key aspects of Zero Tolerance in Anti-Ragging:

1. Strict prohibition of ragging in any form.
2. Severe penalties for those found guilty of ragging, including expulsion or criminal charges.
3. Active monitoring and surveillance to detect and prevent ragging incidents.
4. Support systems for victims of ragging, such as counseling and complaint mechanisms.
5. Awareness campaigns and workshops to educate students about the harmful effects of ragging.
6. Involvement of faculty, staff, and students in anti-ragging initiatives.
7. Regular monitoring and review of anti-ragging measures to ensure effectiveness.
8. At the time of enrolment, the girl students have to fill an undertaking form that they will not commit any such incident of ranking or sexual harassment with any other girl students, otherwise the college administration will be forced to take action against them.

The objective is to create a ragging-free environment, promoting a culture of respect, inclusivity, and academic excellence.





A one day workshop on preserving the planet empowering action for a sustainable future under the umbrella of the IQAC cell of the Yodh Singh Namdhari Mahila college Daltonganj was held today in its well maintained auditorium.

Divisional forest officer Medininagar Soumitra Shukla, deputy director North division of the tiger reserve Palamu P Jena and project planning officer waste management Rahul Anand graced the occasion.

From the side of the NP university there came Dr K C Jha proctor. There was the battery of teachers of this college notably Dr Vijay Kumar Prasad, Dr Mashrique, Dr Shobha, Dr Sarita, D K Pandit etc. Dr Mohini Gupta professor in charge of YSN Mahila college in her brief but



thoughtful address emphasised the preservation of environment and advised the students to take initiative in the preservation and conservation of environment.

Dr Mohini (popular by her first name) said the survival of environment is the mainstay of life on earth. It's loss is irreparable she reminded. It's still time to save the environment said Dr Gupta.

Isha asked about solar system while Alia Naaz wanted to know if electronic transport is better than gas driven transport. Priya Singh said how people set goals for good house but not for healthy environment. The girls asked the questions half English and half Hindi! Shukla and Jena were attentive to their questions.

DFO Medininagar Soumitra Shukla used homey examples to drive his point home as to how to save environment and climate. Shukla avoided jargens. He was down to earth.
