**Proceedings of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Meeting
Regarding Admission of Students beyond Sanctioned Seats**

Agenda:

To discuss and deliberate on the admission of students beyond the sanctioned seat capacity at YSNM College, in response to the high demand from applicants applying through the Chancellor's portal, and to seek approval from Nilamber-Pitamber University for such admissions.

Proceedings:

The meeting was called to order by the Chairperson, who highlighted the increasing number of applications received for various courses at YSNM College, particularly from students applying through the Chancellor's portal. The key issue under discussion was the need to address the high demand for admissions, which has exceeded the sanctioned seat capacity of several programs.

Key Points Discussed:

2. Applications Beyond Sanctioned Seats:

The IQAC reviewed the number of applications received through the Chancellor's portal, which clearly indicated that the demand for certain programs had far exceeded the sanctioned seat capacity. In light of this, it was important to explore ways to accommodate as many students as possible without compromising the quality of education or violating any regulatory guidelines.

3. Compliance with University and Regulatory Guidelines:

The IQAC resolved that YSNM College will proceed with the admission of eligible students beyond the sanctioned seat capacity, contingent upon receiving approval from Nilamber-Pitamber University. The College will formally submit a request to the University, outlining the rationale for additional admissions and seeking the necessary permission to admit students beyond the approved limit.

Conclusion:

The meeting concluded with unanimous agreement on the resolution. The College will move forward with seeking the necessary approvals from Nilamber-Pitamber University and take appropriate steps to ensure the successful admission of additional students while maintaining educational excellence.
